ECO CORNER

The St. Kateri Conservation Centre is a US Catholic faith-based conservation organization that promotes faith, integral ecology, and life. It is part of the movement to mitigate climate change and biodiversity collapse by enlisting gardeners, farmers, homeowners or any land managers in the work of ecological restoration. Catholic ecologist Bill Jacobs founded the Centre in 2000 after years of working for secular conservation organizations. "It occurred to me we weren't going to save nature without some reference to God". In recent years, the Centre has expanded to include practical programs promoting conservation and ecological restoration as expressions of faith, including the St. Kateri Habitats and Parks Programme, and the St. Kateri Indigenous Peoples Programme.

FEAST DAYS

Wednesday 29th June - Saints Peter & Paul, Apostles

St. Peter, originally called Simon, a fisherman who became the leader of the apostles, and the rock on which the church is built, died by crucifixion in Rome around the year 64. St Paul, Saul the Pharisee, who became the "Apostle of the Gentiles", was martyred by beheading around 67. Both proclaim with their lives that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the Living God.

Friday 01 July - St. Oliver Plunkett, bishop and martyr

Born into Irish nobility, St. Oliver Plunkett was ordained in Rome in 1654, and was a professor of theology, until he was appointed Archbishop of Armagh in 1669. He was forced to work covertly during the suppression of priests, and was arrested and tried in Dundalk in 1679, for allegedly conspiring against the State. As it was felt he would never be convicted in Ireland, he was moved to a prison in London, where he was found guilty of high treason, "for promoting the Catholic faith", and was hanged, drawn and quartered on 01 July 1681. The first of the Irish Martyrs to be beatified, he was canonised in 1975. He is buried at Downside Abbey, England, and his head is venerated in St. Peter's Church, Drogheda.
