FEAST DAYS (IRISH SAINTS)

Wed 06th : St Moninne of Killeavy was one of Ireland's early women saints. After instruction on the religious life, she founded a community at Sliabh Gullion, Co. Armagh, living a reclusive life, based on that of Elijah and John the Baptist. Moninne died around 517.

Friday 08th : St Kilian was born in the parish of Mullagh, in the diocese of Kilmore. With eleven companions, he left Ireland, and became known as the apostle of Thuringia and Eastern Franconia (Germany). He was put to death in 689. There is a strong devotion to him in Würzburg, where his remains lie, and also throughout the Bavarian countryside.
