COVID-19 UPDATE

After a significant increase in COVID-19 infections earlier this summer due to the extremely transmissible Omicron variants, we now appear to have passed the peak of this latest wave. In light of this, we have reviewed our current protocols and have decided that it is appropriate at this point to discontinue the regular sanitisation of our churches. Pre-pandemic arrangements for cleaning will be re-instated. While there is reason to be cautiously optimistic going forward, there is still some uncertainty about the path this pandemic will take as we head into the autumn and winter months. The following precautions therefore will remain in place in line with diocesan guidelines:

- -The wearing of face coverings is strongly recommended, in keeping with the current Public Health advice in relation to indoor public places including places of worship
- -The use of hand sanitiser on entering and exiting the church and before using the holy water fonts is strongly recommended
- -The socially distanced sections in both churches will be maintained for those who wish to exercise ongoing caution
- -Ventilation will continue to be maximised
- -The physical Sign of Peace remains suspended and Holy Communion should be received in the hand only We will continue to keep the situation under regular review.
