WORLD DAY OF PEACE 2023

The World Day of Peace — instituted by St. Paul VI in 1968 — is celebrated each year on January 1st, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. The message is sent to governments around the world by the Vatican Secretariat of State.

The pope's message for the 56th World Day of Peace is titled "No one can be saved alone: Combatting COVID-19 together, embarking together on paths of peace."

In his message of peace, Pope Francis posed a series of questions: "What did we learn from the pandemic? What new paths should we follow to cast off the shackles of our old habits, to be better prepared, to dare new things? What signs of life and hope can we see, to help us move forward and try to make our world a better place?"

Pope Francis makes reference to the ongoing war in Ukraine where he described it as a "setback for the whole of humanity". "At the very moment when we dared to hope that the darkest hours of the COVID-19 pandemic were over, a terrible new disaster befell humanity. We witnessed the onslaught of another scourge: another war, to some extent like that of COVID-19, but driven by culpable human decisions ... Clearly, this is not the post-COVID era we had hoped for or expected," Pope Francis said.

The Pope added: "the greatest lesson we learned from Covid-19 was the realisation that we all need one another"; highlighting the need of "embarking together on paths of peace".


