WORLD DAY OF THE SICK

Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes (Saturday 11th February)

"Dear brothers and sisters, when we go on a journey with others, it is not unusual for someone to feel sick, to have to stop because of fatigue or of some mishap along the way. It is precisely in such moments that we see how we are walking together: whether we are truly companions on the journey, or merely individuals on the same path, looking after our own interests and leaving others to "make do". For this reason, on the 31st World Day of the Sick, as the whole Church journeys along the synodal path, I invite all of us to reflect on the fact that it is especially through the experience of the vulnerability and illness that we can learn to walk together according to the style of God, which is closeness, compassion and tenderness.



It is not only what functions well or those who are productive that matter. Sick people, in fact, are at the centre of God's people, and the Church advances together with them as a sign of humanity in which everyone is precious and no one should be discarded or left behind.


