

# CELEBRATING THE CENTENARY OF THE CANONISATION OF ST THÉRÈSE

In October1997 Pope John Paul II declared St Thérèse a Doctor of the Church, the youngest of the thirty-three Saints called Doctors, and bestowed on only three women since the beginning of the Church. This is a very special title indicating the depth of spiritual knowledge of God, which is considered to be

extraordinary, and could only be gained by revelations from on high of the Divine Truth.

"Our Lord made me understand that the only true glory is that which lasts forever; and that to attain it, there is no necessity to do brilliant deeds, but rather to hide from the eyes of others, and even from oneself, so that the left hand knows not what the right hand is doing"


