A day of great joy for all those devoted to St Thérèse was World Mission 19th October 1997, when Saint John Paul 11 proclaimed her a Doctor of

the Church. St Thérèse, who once said, "I would like to enlighten souls as did the doctors", became the third female Doctor of the Church. Saint John Paul stated, "Thérèse of the Child Jesus and the Holy Face is the youngest, but her spiritual path is so mature and ardent, the intuitions of faith present in her writings are so vast and profound, as to have earned her a place among the great masters of the Spirit".

our amazing young parishioners, everyone is welcome. Bring a friend, bring your family, let's fill the church! Don't miss it — God is doing great things among our young people!


