

THE CLOSE OF THE JUBILEE **YEAR 2025**

The Jubilee Year will be officially closed by Pope Leo on January 6th, the Feast of the Epiphany.

Bishop Alan McGuckian will celebrate the Rite of the Closing of the Jubilee Year with Mass at 3.00pm in St Peter's Cathedral, Belfast on Sunday 4th January 2026. He would like to invite as many as possible, from across the Diocese, to join him for the Mass and some refreshments afterwards in St Comgall's Centre. While the Jubilee Year of Hope will formally close, the task ahead will be to carry its Message of Hope with us into the New Year 2026.

CHURCH OF THE RESURRECTION DOORS

Many of you may know that the bronze doors in the Church of the Resurrection, designed by Carolyn Mulholland, were severely vandalised some time ago. Following negotiation with the Insurance Company, a discretionary payment was made to cover the cost of repair and restoration of the doors. This work has been completed, and the doors, depicting the moment the Risen Christ invited Thomas to touch his wounds, have been positioned in the Gathering Space of Holy Family Church.



To mark their installation, Bishop Alan will celebrate the 10.30am Mass on Sunday 11th January 2026, and bless the doors. It will be a fitting end to our Jubilee 2025 celebrations, with its emphasis on the theme of Hope, as the Lord's Resurrection is the basis of Christian hope.
